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## Mass Spectrometric Separation and Determination of N<sup>1</sup>,N<sup>12</sup>-Diacetylspermine in the Urine of Cancer Patients

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An ionspray ionization mass-spectrometric method for the determination of  $N^1,N^{12}$ -diacetylspermine (Ac<sub>2</sub>Spm) was developed using <sup>15</sup>N-labeled Ac<sub>2</sub>Spm as the internal standard. Concentrations of Ac<sub>2</sub>Spm in the urine obtained from 17 cancer patients measured by the present method correlated well with those measured by ELISA, showing the usefulness of the two methods.
